

Privacy Policy

The Press Council respects the privacy of every visitor to our website. Given that we collect different types of information about users, we want you to understand the conditions under which we process your data. This privacy policy is valid within the entire website www.savetzastampu.rs, and does not apply to other websites that can be accessed through the links indicated on our website. Those sites have their own privacy policies that we cannot influence.

Why and which of your personal data we collect

We collect only those data that are necessary for the purpose for which they are collected. For the purposes of submitting complaints and filling out the contact form, we may ask you to provide us with your first and last name, address, phone number and email address.

How we further process your Personal Data

The Press Council will not transfer your personal data to external collaborators without your consent. Some of the information you give us for the purposes of filing complaints must be published on the site, in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act.
